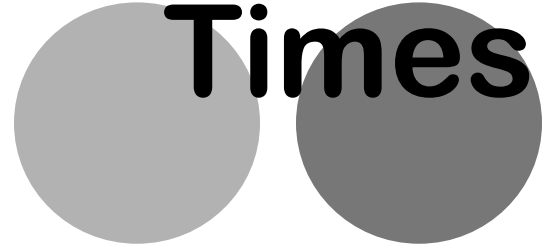
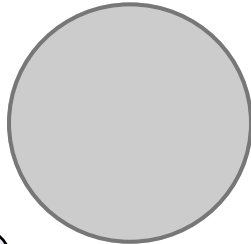

## \*\*Kindergarten Transition Day\*\*

Tuesday, May 25th

Current kindergartners will be with guest teachers/substitute teachers on this day while the kindergarten teachers work with incoming kindergartners and their parents.
