Beginner Model Rocketry Club, Team Tuesday begins **today. All members should come to W-241 after second bus call. Please bring a pencil**

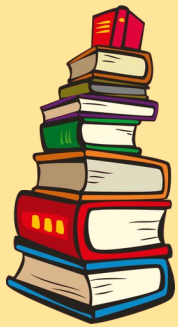


Board Game Club

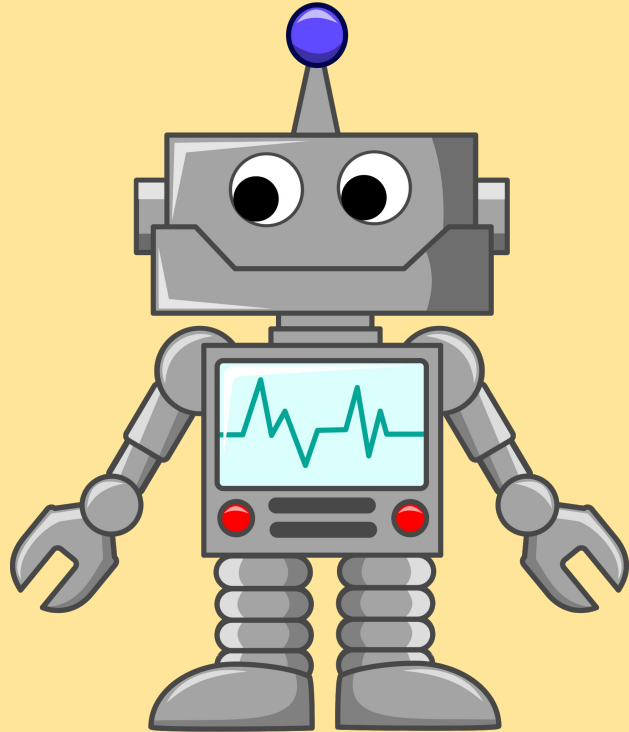


Photography Club
