

# WHAT'S HAPPENING AROUND SCHOOL : SCREENWRITING CLUB

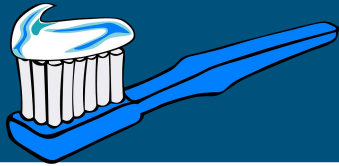
