

One Volume Reference Book

(Ex. ~Dictionary, one volume encyclopedia, almanac...)

1. Author of article Last name, (comma) First name. (period) → *if given*
2. “Title of article.” (in quotation marks) (period)
3. Title of Reference Book . (underlined) (period)
4. Edited by Editor’s first and last name. (period) → *if given*
5. Publisher, (comma)
6. Copyright date, (comma)
7. Page numbers for article. (period)
8. Medium of Publication. (period)
