

Picture or Image - Print Source

1. Photographer/artist's Last name, (comma) First name. (period) *if given*
2. "Description or title of image." (in quotation marks) (period)
3. Descriptive word. (photo, map, cartoon, drawing, etc) (period)
4. The rest of the entry should follow the format for the source.
[For example, if the image was found in a book, newspaper or magazine follow the format for that type of source!!]
5. Complete the entry by adding the page number for the image. (period)
6. Medium of Publication. (period)
