



Book Review of *The Serpent's Shadow* (Book #3 in the Kane Chronicles Series)

The Serpent's Shadow by Rick Riordan is a wonderful book filled with excitement, adventure, and a little humor. This book is about Carter and Sadie Kane trying to save the world from Apophis who says he will swallow the sun. But, they are blocked by many things. Walt Stone, their first initiate at the Brooklyn House, is at the brink of death. Zia Rashid, their very close friend who lives at the House of Life, is stuck babysitting the senile Lord Ra. The only way to save the world is to accept help from Setne, the ghost of an insane magician. Will they succeed or not?

My favorite part of the book is when Neith, the hunting goddess, is hunting for Sadie and Walt for their pockets and keeps failing. At the end, Sadie went off on a tangent about Jelly Babies. That distracted Neith. Sadie and Walt survive after that.

If you like Egyptian Mythology, then you will love this book. But, in order to read this book you have to read books #1 and #2 in the Kane Chronicles series: *The Red Pyramid* and *The Throne of Fire*. I recommend this book to anyone who likes Rick Riordan books.
