MONITORING: NO CONFIRMED CASES IN SUBURBAN PHILADELPHIA/ MONTGOMERY COUNTY

SPRING-FORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL REMAIN OPEN

- SFASD will remain in contact with the Montgomery County Office of Public Health and the Pennsylvania Department of Education
- Monitor activities locally and regionally
- Provide preventative education in all schools
- Provide preventative education to families
- Daily cleaning of classrooms, bathrooms, locker rooms, hallways and stairwells, cafeterias and large group rooms, and school buses

LIMITING: CONFIRMED CASES IN SUBURBAN PHILADELPHIA/MONTGOMERY COUNTY

SPRING-FORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL REMAIN OPEN

- SFASD will remain in contact with the Montgomery County Office of Public Health and the Pennsylvania Department of Education
- Will continue all measures in the Monitoring Stage
- Consider postponing outside groups' events in our buildings; reschedule if possible
- Consider limiting large audience attendance (800+ individuals) at Spring-Ford schools
- Consider postponing student and staff travel in areas that are a focus of infection; reschedule if possible
- Consider denying school access to groups that have traveled from areas that are a focus of infection

POSTPONING: GROWING NUMBER OF CONFIRMED CASES IN SUBURBAN PHILADELPHIA/MONTGOMERY COUNTY

SPRING-FORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL REMAIN OPEN

- SFASD will remain in contact with the Montgomery County Office of Public Health and the Pennsylvania Department of Education
- Will continue all measures in the Monitoring Stage
- Consider postponing all travel and field trips, rescheduling if possible
- Consider suspending parent volunteers
- Consider postponing all district-sponsored events, rescheduling if possible
- Consider postponing all athletic and extracurricular activities, rescheduling if possible

CLOSING: COMMUNITY SPREAD AND/OR MULTIPLE CONFIRMED CASES IN SPRING-FORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT

- SFASD will remain in contact with the Montgomery County Office of Public Health and the Pennsylvania Department of Education
- SFASD will follow guidelines issued by PDE and the Secretary of Education
- Will continue all measures in the Monitoring Stage
- Essential employees will be on call
- SFASD will suspend all curricular and instructional activities, as well as all extracurricular activities
