Thank you in advance for joining us for our 2018-2019 Open House. We hope this night will provide you with a general sense of what your child's daily life is like here at Spring-Ford High School.

The main goal this evening is to allow parents the opportunity to meet their child's teachers while obtaining a brief overview of the courses and their syllabi. Unfortunately due to time constraints, there will be no time available for individual teacher conferences. Parent/teacher conferences are scheduled for November 15, 19, and 20; specific details and times for those conferences will be communicated in the coming weeks.

Members of the Golden Ram Marching Band will be on hand to greet you at the front of the building, and members of the Orchestra will be on hand to greet you inside the Gymnasium/Auditorium lobby. However, you may enter through any of the doors in the building. National Honor Society students will greet you and give directional guidance throughout the evening.

Please move promptly to your child's Day "1" 1st period class. Your 1st period teacher will provide you with a copy of your child's schedule to follow for the evening.

In the 10-12th Grade Center, we operate on a six-day cycle. As stated previously, this evening will follow the Day "1" schedule. Once 1st period has concluded, you will proceed to the remaining classes listed on your daughter's or son's schedule. Below is the planned schedule for the evening:

*If you are unable to obtain your son's or daughter's schedule during 1st period, please report to the appropriate House office for assistance. Individual teacher conferences may be scheduled at the House office as well, if deemed necessary.

As you progress through your child's schedule this evening, you will likely encounter a study hall along with your child's scheduled lunch period. Parents of students who attend our technical school will encounter an unscheduled AM or PM portion to their daily schedule. When these times do occur, we encourage all of you to visit the many special areas of the building, e.g., the House offices, Athletic office, Future Planning Center, Media Center, Television Studio, etc. You are also encouraged to visit the cafeteria where many of our student activity groups are prepared to share information about their specific clubs and special school programs. Many other organizations, which are an integral part of your child's high school experience, will be available there as well – staff members from the Western Montgomery Career and Technology Center (our vocational technical school), Home and School, Athletic Booster Club, Spring-Ford Music Association, SNAP (Students Need an Alternative Party – after prom), Spring-Ford Food Services, Jostens (class rings, diplomas, caps/gowns), and Creative Health Counseling, to name a few.
