 - o Mrs. DeLange and four students made a presentation of the club
 - The stated goal of the club: To provide opportunities for our students that encourage the strengthening of social skills and the chance to establish positive peer relationships
 - The students told the committee about their mentoring experiences with the special needs students and how it gives them a change to interact with special needs students and meet new friends
 - The club has monthly activities, which includes playing various games with the mentors and buddies
