

Lessons Learned

Students:

Students needed training on the devices, just as much as the teachers.

Teachers:

- > Teachers needed training on:
 - > Instructional strategies (utilizing the tools)
 - Classroom management (utilizing the tools)
 - Technology tools devices, software, and online resources

Learning Management:

- Learning Management was important for managing classroom activities
 - Google Classroom was used successfully and with little training
 - Blackboard was used to a small degree, it was found to be difficult to use

Technology Implications:

- Needed improved wireless network coverage where there was a high density of devices
- Printing required additional software to allow mobile devices to print
- Mobile device management system was required for a large number of devices




Student Survey Results

(91 student respondents)


Did you like the computer device you received?

- Lenovo laptop 26% liked, 74% preferred another device or nothing at all


Did you have experience using the same type of device in the past?




Did you use your device for schoolwork in your other classes?




How important was it to be able to take your device home with you?




Do you own a computer device at home that you can use for schoolwork?

10 Trained Administrative Leaders and 100 Trained Teacher Leaders

Personnel:

2 additional Support Technicians
Substitute coverage costs for trainings

Digital Resources:

Content outside of the Curriculum Review Cycle

Infrastructure:

Expanded wireless network

Mobile printing (for student devices)

Mobile device management (for student devices)

Computer Devices:

Increased student access to computer devices in grades 5-8 1:1 student laptop computers in grades 9-12
