Spring-Ford Area High School Art Students Create Mural for the 9th Grade Center Photo/Media Opportunity

ROYERSFORD, PA – Talented 9th grade art students and staff at Spring-Ford Area High School's 9th Grade Center are creating of a series of fused glass mosaics for the school's cafeteria. Students will work with Philadelphia-based mosaic artist Jessica Gorlin Liddell through the Artist in Residence program, coordinated by Art's Alive! The mural will include a series of colorful glass tiles inspired by student photography and drawings. Students and staff collaborated with Gorlin Liddell to add their creative talents to the overall project. Once the glass tiles are complete, they will be kiln fired in Gorlin Liddell's Philadelphia based studio. The project will be installed in the cafeteria mid-March.

The project is facilitated by 9th grade art teachers Mrs. Culp and Mrs. Rudloff, as well as Dr. Weidenbaugh, Principal of the 9th grade center, with the assistance of the Artist in Residence program through Art's Alive!
