

**NOTICE OF INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS**

**OF THE SPRING-FORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT TO INCREASE THE LEVEL OF EXONERATION IN CONNECTION WITH ITS EMERGENCY AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES TAX (HEREIN, "EMST"), EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL FURTHER CHANGED**

Pursuant to law, the Board of School Directors of the Spring-Ford Area School District (herein "Board") has duly passed the EMST, formerly known as the Occupational Privilege Tax, of which the School District receives \$5.00 per year from individuals employed within the School District limits. Currently, individuals earning \$1,000.00 per year may be exonerated from the EMST. The Board has examined the EMST, and it has determined that it would like to provide for the exoneration from the EMST of any individual whose total income from all sources is less than \$12,000.00 per year, excluding income from disability insurance, disability income and Supplemental Security Income. The Board would like to make these revisions to account for changes in the economy. The Board has determined that EMST would yield \$147,000.00 in estimated revenue in fiscal year 2007-2008. Please note that the EMST will otherwise remain unchanged.

**OF THE SPRING-FORD AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT TO INCREASE THE LEVEL OF EXONERATION AND PROVIDE OTHER EXONERATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PER CAPITA TAX, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL FURTHER CHANGED**

Pursuant to law, the Board of School Directors of the Spring-Ford Area School District (herein "Board") has duly passed per capita taxes totaling \$10.00 (herein "Per Capita Tax"). Currently, individuals earning \$5,000.00 and couples earning \$10,000.00 per year may be exonerated from the Per Capita Tax. The Board has examined the Per Capita Tax, and it has determined that it would like to provide for the exoneration from the Per Capita Tax of any individual whose total income from all sources is less than \$12,000.00 per year, excluding income from disability insurance, disability income and Supplemental Security Income. The Board has also determined that it would like to provide for the exoneration of taxpayers as a matter of law in certain situations and for certain individuals on active duty in the armed forces. The Board would like to make these revisions to account for changes in the economy. The Board has determined that the Per Capita Tax would yield \$240,000.00 in estimated revenue in fiscal year 2007-2008. Please note that the Per Capita Tax will otherwise remain unchanged.
