Any senior with plans to attend an institution of higher learning after high school (trade school, two-year college, or four-year college) is invited to attend the programs on Wednesday, June 1.

DETAILS: College 101: How to Make Freshman Year a Success: available during periods 1, 2, 3, 6, and 7 for students to attend during a study hall. During this session, students will have the opportunity to discuss social and academic concerns that they may about college such as living with a roommate, balancing academics and extracurricular activities, where to go with problems on campus, being safe on campus, what it means to go Greek, and any other topics of concern.

College 102: Rising to the Top Freshman Year: starting at 2:30 p.m. This session will focus the differences between high school classes and college level classes. We will talk about how to use a college syllabus, student-faculty relationships, seeking out unique academic opportunities, time management, and any other concerns students may have about college (including social concerns). Students who attended College 101 may also attend College 102.
