Spring-Ford Area High School Receives One of the Top SPP Scores in the State

ROYERSFORD, PA – Spring-Ford Area High School has one of the top highest School Performance Profile (SPP) in the state!

A school's SPP score relies heavily on state assessment scores, but also includes college readiness tests, industry standards-based assessments, graduation, promotion, and attendance rates, as well as evidence of offering rigorous courses as other factors in the calculation.

- Only schools with a Grade 11 cohort had a calculated SPP score for 2014-2015. The SPP score is based on Grade 11 Keystone Exam banked scores.
- Schools that administered only PSSA and PASA did not receive an SPP score for the 2014-2015 school
 year.

In 2013-2014 Spring-Ford's 10-12 Center received an impressive score of 91.3, and the 9th Grade Center received a score of 92.1. In 2014-2015 the Pennsylvania Department of Education recognized the two centers as one high school entity. The Spring-Ford Area high School increased to an outstanding 97.3 in 2014-2015.
