**ROYERSFORD, PA** – Members of the Spring-Ford Area School Board are leading a third march on Harrisburg to bring an end to the state budget impasse. School Board President, Thomas DiBello, and Vice President, Joseph Ciresi, have called upon Pennsylvania's 500 school districts to join the march.

"Join us in the push to get a budget done. Spring-Ford is one of 500 districts across the state; each day that goes by is another day wasted and another day longer," said Ciresi during the February 22, 2016 School Board Meeting. "It is time the 500 school districts get together and march on Harrisburg as a team. When they come back from recess, let us all be there. Let's show that we are taking this seriously."
