The Western Montgomery Career and Technology Center provides programming for students in grades 9 through 12, offering 19 technical programs in a half-day setting.

In order to inform current ninth graders of the opportunities available at WMCTC a representative from the school presented information to ninth grade students during a school assembly on Wednesday, December 20th. In addition, on-site visitations of WMCTC are scheduled for the week of December 4 through the 8th, 2017 for all ninth grade students. Visitations will occur each morning of that week from 8 am to 10 am. Student visitation groups have been arranged according to which teacher they have for social studies. Students will ride school buses to and from WMCTC, and all school rules will apply during their visit.
